## PLANT A BUTTERFLY GARDEN IN YOUR YARD OR BACK ALLEY.

- Plant flowers in your garden. Monarchs love milkweed, which is what caterpillars need to turn into butterflies. You can also plant wildflowers (aster, sunflower, butterfly bush, verbena) for the fall to give monarchs an energy boost for their flight to Mexico.
- Plant your garden in full sun. Butterflies love sunny spots.
- Protect your garden from the wind. Butterflies don't appreciate a gusty garden.
- Add a muddy puddle or wet sand between the flowers.
- Use environmentally friendly ways to kill weeds instead of toxic chemicals.
