Draw a picture of yourself alone or with your huddle.

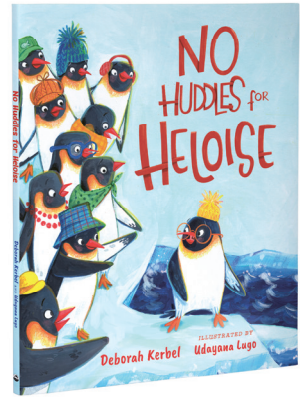
